The Irvine Ranch Water District is located on Sand Canyon Ave. about halfway between the 5 and 405 freeways. The building is on the Northwest corner of Sand Canyon and Waterworks Way. It is easy to enter the visitor parking from Waterworks Way.



When you enter the driveway you will see a sign that will point you to visitor parking. Visitor parking should be completely open at that time since we will arrive after the office hours. Park in an available spot and step out of your car.

The presentation was followed by a 10 minute break.

Old Business

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 PM.

of changing our meeting time & day of the month. It is determined by our chapter bylaws. A motion was made to proceed with the meeting time change in order to acquire a more adequate meeting location. The motion was seconded & carried unanimously.

Cliff Carpenter presented the year 2008 Young Eagle program and gave details of the need for volunteers, both pilot and ground crew, for the next event scheduled January 19th. Volunteers are encouraged to sign up online using the Chapt. 92 website.

President Ray Hecker presented the details of a meeting with Chino interim airport manager, Brett Godown. (See President's letter in Jan., 2008, Hanger Flyer) A motion to give Brett Godown chapter membership was presented and seconded. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.

Roland Koluvek, Treasurer, reported the chapter finances at 18951.78. The Young Eagles has \$7189.72, including \$5000 C.D.

Recognition was given to Cliff Carpenter for his recent transitional training to obtain a tailwheel endorsement. The meeting was opened up to aviation safety discussion, aircraft handling techniques, and future meeting presentations.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 PM.

reviewed and a check for \$321 was issued. Of this sum, \$271 is for insurance and \$50 is for chapter renewal.

Brett Godown, Chino Airport management, was to be added to the Chapt 92 Newsletter list in order that he may be informed of our current and ongoing airport activities with regard to the public interests.

The calendar for 2008 was submitted by Cliff Carpenter. It was discussed and finalized; and, submitted for publication to the members.

Future presentations for chapter membership meetings were discussed and noted by Jay Steffenhagen.

An alternate meeting location which would provide more adequate room for chapter membership meetings was discussed; and, it was determined that Irvine Ranch Water District would be our future meeting location. However, since our normal meeting time of the 1st Wednesday, 7 PM, of each month was not available on the IRWD calendar, the board would need to change Chapter 92 monthly meeting day. A motion was brought forth to amend the bylaws so that Chapter 92 general membership meeting day would be the 1st Tuesday of each month, with the time at 7 PM. The motion was seconded. A discussion followed and the motion was carried by majority of the board.

Expanding the chapter membership by an outreach to Young Eagle pilots and volunteers is to be an ongoing effort throughout 2008. Consideration for future events of special interest to the aviation community can be used to attract new charter membership.

The meeting was open to discussion for exchange of ideas regarding fund raising, airport improvement projects, and chapter recognition projects. The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 PM.
